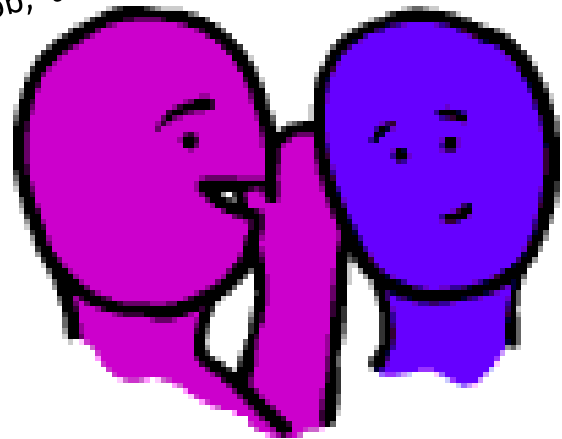


## Other words for *whisper*
